

SASKATCHEWAN BUILDING PERMITS TOP THE CHARTS



Statistics Canada released data showing the value of building permits issued in Saskatchewan had a 37.4 per cent increase from June 2024 compared to June 2025 (seasonally adjusted). This places Saskatchewan second among the provinces for year-over-year growth.


