LIQUOR RETAIL RFP'S RELEASED FOR FIVE MORE COMMUNITIES




The application process for retail liquor store permits in the communities of Yorkton, Melville, Lloydminster, Moose Jaw and Kindersley begins today.

Successful proponents will be selected through a Request for Proposal (RFP) process. There is one opportunity available in each of the five communities.

"This is the second of four rounds of RFPs to be released as part of the transition to an expanded private retail liquor system," Minister responsible for the Saskatchewan Liquor and Gaming Authority Don McMorris said. "The first round of RFPs were released July 7 and pertained to the opportunities in Regina and Saskatoon."

SASKATCHEWAN RAISES CONCERNS ABOUT NEW ALBERTA BEER MARK-UP



Saskatchewan Deputy Premier and Minister responsible for the Saskatchewan Liquor and Gaming Authority Don McMorris said today that the Government of Saskatchewan is very concerned about changes the Government of Alberta recently announced to that province's beer mark-ups and to its incentives for local brewers.

"Alberta's new beer pricing and grant policy are a trade issue that could hurt producers and consumers in both provinces," McMorris said. "We have raised our concerns with Premier Notley's office and Premier Wall will be raising this matter again with Premier Notley at the Premiers' meeting in Whitehorse later this week."

Last Tuesday (July 12), the Alberta government announced that as of August 5, Alberta will move to one standard beer mark-up of \$1.25 per litre regardless of company size, location, or level of production. The proposed change will also see Alberta provide grants to small, Alberta-based producers to support development of that province's industry.

"This policy change is bad news, not only for Alberta beer drinkers but also for all non-Alberta-based brewers that serve the Alberta market," McMorris said. "It will significantly increase the mark-up rate applied in Alberta to Great Western Brewing and other small Saskatchewan producers. This would mean higher prices and less selection for Alberta consumers, as out-of-province breweries will be forced to reconsider that market after having been placed at a significant economic disadvantage to their Alberta counterparts."

THINGS TO KNOW WHEN WORKING WITH A REAL ESTATE AGENT



Released on July 20, 2016Financial and Consumer Affairs Authority of Saskatchewan (FCAA) and the Saskatchewan Real Estate Commission want to remind people who are buying or selling a property that a real estate agent has obligations they must abide by when hired by a client.

"It's important that people know real estate agents have important legal responsibilities to their client," Insurance and Real Estate Director Ian McIntosh said. "Agents must take steps to ensure disclosure of all material facts relating to a property up front, and they must present all written offers in a prompt, objective and unbiased manner."

INCREASE IN RABIES CASES IN SASKATCHEWAN

Saskatchewan Agriculture is reminding residents that rabies is present across much of the province, after several cases of rabies in domestic animals were detected over the last few months.

The province has confirmed 18 cases from January 1, 2016 to July 13, 2016, versus nine cases in the same time period in 2015 and seven in 2014. This includes seven cases in June and three cases to date in July. Four cases involving domestic animals have been confirmed, involving a cow, a cat, a baby lamb and a baby goat. Also confirmed were cases in skunks (eight) and bats (six).
