Saskatchewan moves forward with helicopter air medical service

- Our Government announced that we have signed a service agreement with Shock Trauma Air Rescue Society (STARS).
- The new service will support our existing air and ground ambulance programs, resulting in faster, more responsive emergency air medical services for Saskatchewan people.
- STARS expected to be operational in Saskatchewan by spring 2012!

Saskatchewan and Manitoba partner on MS liberation clinical trial research

- Last year, Saskatchewan became the first province to provide \$5 million to fund clinical trials in an effort to get answer for people who suffer from this devastating disease.
- Manitoba recently announced they are following Saskatchewan's lead and will be investing
 \$5 million in clinical trials for the MS liberation procedure.
- With Manitoba now on board, clinical trials will produce more extensive data and may ultimately determine whether or not the liberation procedure is a valid treatment for MS.
