PICNIC IN THE PARK



TOUR TO THE FORT QU'APPELLE FISH CULTURE STATION



As Minister of Environment, I had the opportunity to tour the Fort Qu'Appelle Fish Culture Station. It was a great experience to see first-hand the hard work and dedication of the employees. The Fort Qu'Appelle Fish Culture Station has the capacity to rear as many as 60 million fish each year. The stock replaces fish populations in waterbodies where winterkill has occurred or natural reproduction is not successful.

SASKATCHEWAN LEADS THE COUNTRY IN MANUFACTURING SALES GROWTH

The Saskatchewan economy continues to lead the way. According to a Statistics Canada report released today, Saskatchewan had the greatest year-over-year growth in manufacturing sales in Canada.

In April 2013, Saskatchewan manufacturing sales increased 6.3 per cent (seasonally adjusted) from the year previous to set a new record for the month of April. This was well ahead of the minus 3.3 per cent average experienced nationally.

"Manufacturing remains an essential driver of the Saskatchewan economy and this report from

Statistics Canada reflects its importance to our growth and success as a province," Economy Minister Bill Boyd said. "It also contributes to our expanding export market and creates jobs and opportunities across the province."

The Government of Saskatchewan proclaimed June 9-15 as Saskatchewan Tourism Week.


Part of a broader national initiative called Tourism Week in Canada, which brings attention to the economic opportunity available to Canada through travel and tourism, Saskatchewan Tourism Week provides an excellent opportunity to broaden awareness about the importance of tourism in this province.

Tourism contributes more than \$2 billion to Saskatchewan's economy annually, and, in 2011, there were more than 11.9 million visits to and within the province. Approximately 57,300 people are employed in tourism or tourism-related jobs.

"Saskatchewan Tourism Week is a time to celebrate our province's wealth of tourism resources – nearly 100,000 pristine lakes, limitless opportunities to explore and enjoy the outdoors, an enviable parks system, fascinating historic sites and attractions, colourful festivals and much more," Minister Responsible for Tourism Saskatchewan Tim McMillan said. "It also provides an opportunity to acknowledge those who drive the success of the industry and make Saskatchewan a great place to visit."

NEW STUDENT LOAN YEAR UNDERWAY

The 2013-14 student loan year is in full swing. Students can begin submitting their applications for student financial assistance for academic programs beginning on or after August 1, 2013.

"Our government understands the importance of post-secondary education," Advanced Education Minister Don Morgan said. "That's why we've provided record funding in student supports to ensure our students can excel in their post-secondary studies."

The 2013-14 provincial budget provides \$117 million in student supports, a 20 per cent increase from last year's budget. That includes programs such as student loans, bursaries, grants and scholarships.


RECORD NUMBER OF SASKATCHEWAN JOB OPPORTUNITIES IN MAY

If you're searching for a job, Saskatchewan is still the place to look. A record 17,767 jobs were posted on the popular saskjobs.ca website in May 2013, an increase of 5.89 per cent over the same period last year. The previous high was 17,398 jobs in August 2012.

"The Saskatchewan economy continues to lead the nation and the opportunities available on the Saskjobs site are evidence of that," Economy Minister Bill Boyd said. "With jobs available in 349 communities across the province, the opportunities are exciting and abundant for job seekers in Saskatchewan."

- Saskatoon has the second lowest unemployment rate (3.9 per cent) among all CMAs.
- Saskatoon employment rose by 12,000 (8.0 per cent) over the past year.
- Full time employment in the province is up by 15,000 and part-time is down by 1,200.
